GOD MADE EVERYTHING

Genesis 1:1, 27, 31 & 2:1

- 1:1In the beginning God made the heavens and the earth.
- 27God made people God made people in his image God made them male and female.
- 2:1So God finished making all the many, many things in the heavens and on the earth. 1:31God looked at everything he made: It was <u>very good!</u>

HOW DID GOD MAKE MEN & WOMAN? Genesis 2:7-25

- 2:7(First) God took dirt and God made a man from the dirt. God breathed into the man's nose and the man became alive. 8God planted a garden the Garden of Eden. And God put the man in the garden. 15God gave the man a job. The man had to work the garden and the man had to take care of the garden.
- 18And God said, "The man is alone it is <u>not good</u> to be alone. I will make a helper for the man the helper will fit him.
- 19God had made the animals and birds from the dirt [so] God brought all the animals and birds to the man. And God gave the man a job the man had to name all the animals and birds. 20So the man named all the animals and birds. [The man saw all the animals and birds,] but the man could not find a good helper.
- 21So God made the man fall asleep. And God took one of the man's ribs. 22Then God made a woman from the rib. And God brought the woman to the man.
- 23The man said: "She came from my body she is just like me! I will call her 'woman' because she came from 'man'."
- 24This is why a man will leave his father and mother and the man will be united to his wife and the husband and wife will become one body.
- 25The man and his wife were both naked but they felt no shame.

- The man named and saw all the animals and birds, but what did he not find? (verse 20)
- Then what did God do? (verses 21-22)
- The man had seen all the wonderful birds and animals. But how did he feel when he saw the first woman? (verse 23)
- Who made marriage? (verse 24) Whose idea was marriage?

Did marriage just come from our culture? From Japanese or American culture?

God joins a husband and wife together. So people must not separate them.

Mark 10:9

- Who can get married? (verses 23-24)
- What happens when a man and woman get married? (verse 24)

How are a husband and wife (2 persons-1 body) like God (3 Persons-1 God)?

How is marriage like Jesus Christ's relationship to his Church?

[Church = all people in heaven and on earth who believe in Jesus]

21You respect and believe in Jesus Christ, so submit to each other.
22Wives, submit to your husbands – submit to your husbands like you submit to Jesus Christ. 23Christ is the head of the Church – and the husband is the head of the wife. 25Husbands, love your wives – love your wives like Christ loved the Church. Christ died on the cross for the Church. 28Husbands, do what Christ did – love your wives – love your wives like you love your own bodies. Do you love your wife? Then you are loving

yourself! 32This is an amazing mystery: that Christ and the Church are like marriage. 33[So] each husband must love his wife like he loves himself.

And the wife must respect her husband.

Husbands and wives must submit to each other. (Ephesians 5:21)

1You are united with Jesus Christ. 2So think like Jesus thinks – love each other like Jesus loves – follow Jesus' purpose together – be united together in Jesus' Spirit. 3Don't be selfish – don't think only about your own goals. And don't think: I am very great! But be humble, and think: She is more important than I am – he is more important than I am. 4Don't only think about what you want and need – also think about what other people want and need.
