We Must Put Off & Put On

8We died on the cross with Jesus. 6Our Old Self* was a slave to Sin – but our Old Self* was put on the cross with Jesus. So, now, we are not Sins's slaves. 7Why? Because we have died – our Old Self* died with Jesus. So we are free from Sin – 14now Sin is not our slave master.

Romans 6:6-7, 14

So...

Put off your Old Self*. Put on your New Self.

Ephesians 4:22, 24

Put Off Your Old Self*:

Ephesians 4:25-31 & 5:3-4, 12, 18

25Put off telling lies – and speak the truth to each other – because we belong to each other.

Why is it important to tell the truth?

If we lie to each other, what happens to our relationships?

26When you get angry, don't sin – then when the sun sets, stop being angry. 27Don't give Satan a place in your life.

When is it okay to get angry? What do you think?

When should we stop being angry?

Why is it dangerous to continue being angry?

28Are you stealing? Then stop stealing – and work – do something useful, so you can give things to people who need help.

Of course, we work to take care of ourselves and our families? Why else should we work?

29Don't say rotten things – but only say what is good for other people – say the things that help people grow.

What is the main purpose of talking to people?

30Don't make God's Holy Spirit sad and upset – because the Holy Spirit guarantees that you will be saved when Jesus comes back!

31Throw away your bitter feelings, your anger, your arguing and complaining, the negative things you say about other people, and everything that is bad.

5:3In your group, don't have any greed.

5:3In your group, don't have any sexual sin, any dirty thoughts, words or actions – these things are not right for God's pure people. 4Have no stupid talk or dirty jokes – that is not right for God's people. But tell God what you are thankful for. 12It is shameful to even talk about the bad, secret things that unbelievers do.

18Don't get drunk on alcohol – because terrible things come from being drunk – but be filled with the Holy Spirit.
