HOW DO BELIEVERS IN JESUS CONTROL SIN?

Cain's Impossible Duty

Genesis 4:6-7

6God said to Cain, 7"Do what is right – and I will accept you. But, if you do wrong, sin is crouching at your door - sin wants to have you. But you must rule over sin - you must control sin."

> This is Option #1: Do Good, Rule Over Sin & Live Forever

What does Sin want to do to us? (verse 7)

Jesus said, "Do you sin? Then you are Sin's slave."

John 8:34

If we say: "I have never sinned" - we are saying: "God is a liar."

1 John 1:10

How serious is this problem? How serious is it to be Sin's slave?

Jesus said, "Are you Sin's slave? Then you are not part of God's family forever – because a slave is not part of a family forever - a slave is only a worker in the family. But a son is part of God's family forever! John 8:34-35

Jesus said, "I am God's Son [so I have God's power]. So I can free you from being Sin's slave. If I make you free, you will really be free!" John 8:35-36

> Who can make us free from being sin's slave? Who can make us a son in God's family?

> > This is Option #2: Believe in Jesus & Live Forever

How Did Jesus Make Us Free?

Our Old Self* was a slave to Sin - but our Old Self was put on the cross with Christ. So, now, we are not Sins's slaves. Why? Because we have died (our Old Self* has died) – so we are free from Sin. ...Sin is not our slave master.

Romans 6:6-7, 14

(A dead slave doesn't have to obey the slave master anymore! Romans 6:7, 14 & 7:1-4)

Are you in Christ – do you believe in Christ? Then you are brand new! The original you has gone. Look! You have become new! 1 Corinthians 5:17

We have a New Self!

Obeying God comes from faith.

Romans 1:5

Believe in Jesus (faith) —> Get a New Self/Live Forever —> Do good

We must believe in Jesus first. Then we do good.

But, we don't automatically control sin and do good.

Until we leave this body and see Jesus face-to-face,
we have to fight against Sin and our Old Self*.

So, we can go back to our sins if we want to – because ...

The Old Self* wants the opposite of what the Holy Spirit wants – and the Holy Spirit wants the opposite of what the Old Self* wants. They are fighting each other. That is why you don't do what you want to do.

Galatians 5:17

Our Old Self* hates God. It does not obey God's Law – in fact, our Old Self* cannot obey God's Law. If your Old Self* controls you, you cannot please God.

Romans 8:7-8

If you don't believe in Jesus, you are controlled by your Old Self*. You cannot make God happy.

But there is good news! Now we <u>can</u> please God!

3We meet the expectations of God's Law, if we follow the Holy

Spirit – and don't follow the Old Self*.

Romans 8:4

So every day we must choose:

Do I want to follow God's Holy Spirit today?

Or do I want to follow my Old Self* today?

What does God's Law expect?

37Jesus said, "'Love your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, ... [30] and with all your strength...' 38This is the first command. 39The second command is like the first command: 'Love other people like you love yourself.'"

Matthew 22:35-40 [Mark 12:30]

We can only love God and love people with the Holy Spirit's help.

So, How Can We Control Sin? How Can We Do Good?

1. Follow the Holy Spirit:

Live every day by the <u>Holy Spirit's</u> power – then you won't satisfy the evil desires of your Old Self*.

Galatians 5:16

2. Think Right:

Don't copy the world – don't <u>think</u> and do what the world does. But be changed – be changed by <u>thinking new thoughts</u> – by cleaning up your <u>mind</u>.

Romans 12:2

<u>Focus your minds</u> on things above – on things in heaven where Christ is. Don't focus your minds on things of this world.

Colossians 3:1-2

<u>Think</u> about yourselves this way: You are dead to sin – but you are alive to

Romans 6:11

3. Follow God's Word – the Bible:

11God, I keep <u>your Word (the Bible)</u> in my heart, so I won't sin against you. 15 I think deeply about what you want me to do – and I think deeply about what you do. 105 <u>Your Word</u> is a light for my path.

Psalm 119:11, 15, 105

4. Give Your Body to God:

19God gave you his Holy Spirit – and the Holy Spirit lives in your body – your body is the Holy Spirit's temple. You do not own your body – your body does not belong to you. 20Why? Because Jesus bought you with his blood – with his life. So use your body to honor God.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

Give your <u>bodies</u> to God – give your <u>bodies</u> as living sacrifices to God – and keep your <u>bodies</u> pure. This makes God happy – this is how to serve and worship him. Please do this, because God loves you so much.

Romans 12:1

Don't let Sin be the boss in your <u>body</u> – don't obey Sin's evil desires. Romans 6:12

The many parts of your body are "tools." Don't give them to Sin – don't use them as tools to do bad things. But give the parts of your body to God – use them as tools to do good.

Romans 6:13

^{* &}quot;Old Self" is used here because it is easier to understand. In Greek (the New Testament's language) the word is: "flesh" – which does not mean our physical bodies, but (apparently) is everything in us and about us that opposes God, and cannot, and will not please him.
