## WHY DID CREATOR GOD CHOOSE JACOB? GENESIS 25:20-34 & 27:1-41

25:20Isaac was 40 years old when he married Rebekah. 21But Rebekah could not have children.

So Isaac prayed to Creator God for her. Then God answered Isaac's prayer, and Rebekah became pregnant. 23And God said to Rebekah, "Two nations are inside you. And the older son will serve the younger son – the younger son will rule the older son."

24Rebekah gave birth to twins. 25The first boy's name was Esau. 26Then Esau's brother came out – and the younger brother was grabbing Esau's heel. So the younger brother was named Jacob ("he grabs the heel" or "deceiver"). Isaac was 60 years old when the twins were born.

27The boys grew up. Esau became a very good hunter – he liked the prairie. But Jacob was a quiet man – he stayed near the tents. 28Isaac loved Esau, because Isaac liked to eat wild meat. But Rebekah loved Jacob.

## **Esau's Bad Decision**

29One day Jacob was cooking stew – and Esau came back from the prairie – and Esau was very hungry. 30Esau said to Jacob, "Quick! Give me some stew. I'm very hungry!" 31Jacob answered, "First, sell your oldest son's inheritance to me." 32Esau said, "I'm very hungry – so I will die soon! I don't need my inheritance." 33So Esau sold his inheritance to Jacob. 34So Esau hated his inheritance – he sold it for a bowl of stew. Then Jacob gave the stew to Esau – and Esau ate it, then stood up and walked away.

## Jacob Cheats His Brother Esau

27:1 When Isaac was old, his eyes were bad – and he could not see. Isaac said to his oldest son Esau, 2"I am an old man. Maybe I will die soon. 3So get your bow and arrows – and go out to the prairie and hunt a wild animal for me. 4Then make the delicious food that I like to eat. I will eat it – then I will bless you before I die. (You are my oldest son, so I will give you my special blessing – the blessing is about your future.)" 5So Esau went out to the prairie.

5But Rebekah was listening – she heard what Isaac said to Esau. 6So Rebekah said to her son Jacob, 7"Your father will bless your brother Esau – he will bless Esau before God. 9So, go and bring me two young goats. I will make some delicious food for your father – I will make food that he loves. 10Then you take the food to your father. He will eat it – then your father will bless you before he dies."

17Then she gave the delicious food to Jacob. 25So Jacob brought the food to his father – and Isaac ate it. 27Then Isaac blessed Jacob: 28"God give you much grain and new wine. 29Nations will serve you and bow down to you. Rule over your brothers – your brothers will bow down to you. People who curse you will be cursed – and people who bless you will be blessed."

30Isaac finished blessing Jacob, and Jacob left his father. Just then, Esau came in from hunting. 31Esau also made delicious food – and he brought it to his father. Esau said, "My father, eat my wild meat – then bless me." 32Isaac said, "Who are you?" Esau answered, "I am your oldest son Esau."

33Then Isaac trembled very hard. And Isaac said, "Who came in before you? I blessed him – and he will certainly be blessed." [All the special blessing goes to one son.]

34Then Esau cried a loud, bitter cry, "Bless me – bless me, too, my father!" 35But Isaac said, "Your brother came and he lied and he took your blessing."

41 Esau hated Jacob because Jacob got the blessing from his father. Esau said to himself, "My father will die soon. Then I will kill my brother Jacob."

• When did God choose Jacob? (Genesis 25:23)

Before the twins were born– before the twins did anything good or badGod said to Rebekah, "The older son will serve the younger son." So it doesnot depend on what we do – it depends on God.Romans 9:11-12

Why do you think God chose Jacob?

God says, "I loved Jacob."

Who chooses? Do we choose God? Or does God choose us?

Creator God does whatever he wants – God does what he wants in heaven

So, it does not depend on what <u>we want</u> – and it does not depend on what	
we do. But it depends on God's kindness to us.	Romans 9:16
Jesus said, "You did not choose me. But I chose you."	John 15:16
So what should we do? If God can do whatever he wants and if God can choose anyone that he wants how should we respond to God?	
A man prayed to God. The man did not even look up to heaven – but he felt very sad and very sorry. And he said, "God, I am a sinner – please be kind to me." So God forgave that man – God made him good. Luke 18:13-14	
Jesus said, "Whoever comes to me I will never push away."	John 6:37
Often, getting married is the same:
